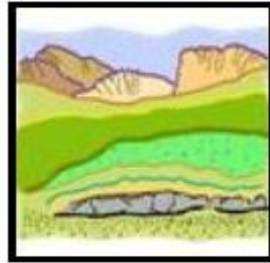


The Napa Valley Museum Presents....

**A Geological Field Trip
to the
June Foote Botanical Preserve**

Join Naturalist Joe Callizo on a guided tour of the Grace Foote Botanical Preserve atop Mt. George. The Grace Foote Preserve features dramatic igneous rock outcroppings formed 3-5 million years ago from the Sonoma Volcanics. Meet at the museum parking lot at 9:00AM and carpool to Mt. George. On this easy one mile hike, Joe will identify plant life, early pioneer history, and the geology of this local Napa Valley Land Trust treasure.

The Napa Valley Museum is located on the grounds of the Veterans Home in Yountville. Take the Highway 29/ Veterans Home Exit .
