 Update and discussion on draft comment letter from WICC Ad-hoc Subcommittee on State Water Resources Control Board's Draft Policy for Maintaining Instream Flows in Northern California Coastal Streams, and consideration and possible direction to staff to submit recommendation letter to the Board of Supervisors. The Board discussed the language in the letter and directed staff to make various changes. Motion and approval was made to provide the comment recommendation letter to the Board of Supervisors for their consideration with the recommended changes, with Robert Steinhauer opposed.

<u>Outcome</u>: Discussion and Action. Motion and approval was made to provide \$5,000 to match existing project funds in support of the purchase and installation of creek identification signs along major creek crossings throughout Napa County.

b. Discussion and possible direction to Staff regarding WICC support/funding for the development and publication of a Historical Watershed Atlas for the Napa River, to match pending State and local funding/support, establish a historical basis for future restoration efforts and opportunities, build a historical context of watershed consciousness and stewardship, and support efforts relating to May 2008 Watershed Awareness Month and upcoming Watershed Symposium on May 22nd (San Francisco Estuary Institute/Staff)

<u>Outcome</u>: Discussion and Action. Rainer Hoenicke (SFEI) provided the Board with a presentation on SFEI's Historical Ecology Project, highlighting their work in the Napa Valley. The Board motioned and approved \$10,000 in support towards the development of a Historical Watershed Atlas of the Napa Valley for use by the WICC to support Watershed Awareness Month, the upcoming Watershed Symposium and mapping information on the WICC WebCenter.
