






Zebra and Quagga Mussel Sightings Distribution Dreissena polymorpha and D. rostriformis bugensis



Lake Berryessa Outreach Program


- Part of the Lake Berryessa Watershed Partnership (1999)
 - SCWA, USBR, Solano RCD, Solano County/Cities, Napa County, and others
 - Solano RCD provides lead role for Partnership (but funded by others)
 - Solano RCD involved in education and land stewardship throughout Solano County

• Lake Berryessa Outreach (LBO) Program

- Program started in 2006
- In 2006 (1-part time intern, 3 mo)
- In 2015 (11-full time intern, 5 mo)
- Starting in 2012, SCWA began hiring/funding LBO Interns
- In 2015 received DBW Grant, allowed further expansion of the LBO program
- Have applied for 2016-2017 DBW Grant




Lake Berryessa Outreach – Intern Hours per Year


Lake Berryessa Outreach – Accomplishments


- Screened 9,197 Boats for Invasive Mussels
