

Goals

- Provide grant funding support to various groups and non-profits for projects related to wildlife conservation, such as wildlife rehabilitation, stream and habitat restoration and monitoring, environmental education, native plant nursery, and others.
- Wildlife Commission outreach and participation in various local and regional environmental events, such as Napa Earth Day, Watershed Awareness Month activities, Napa County Watershed Symposium, San Francisco Bay Flyway Festival, and others.
- Provide grant funding opportunities for the community that will address specialized or seasonal needs and support the Wildlife Conservation Commission mission.
- Provide support for local fish and wildlife projects affected by State funding reductions through targeted grant funding.
- Wildlife Commission members continue to review grant projects, and provide status reports during regular meetings to help determine effectiveness of projects/grants.

6. Support for CALTIP Rewards – \$1,000


