The Fish Friendly Farming (FFF) program is enrolling new sites year round. **Over 70,000 acres and 800 farms are already enrolled in Napa County.** The FFF program has been approved as a compliance program under the Agricultural Water Quality Permit for Napa and Sonoma. CLSI staff will work with you to conduct a site assessment and complete your farm plan. Once the farm plan is complete, your site is ready for certification. Unlike government programs, CLSI is a private nonprofit organization and not subject to the Public Record Act so your farm plan remains a private document. CLSI assists landowners to implement projects by applying for grants and permits.
