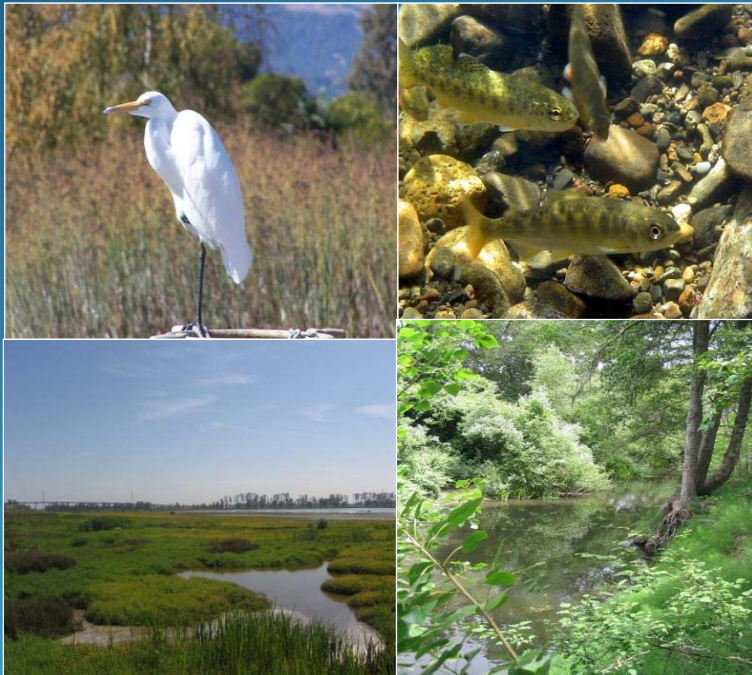
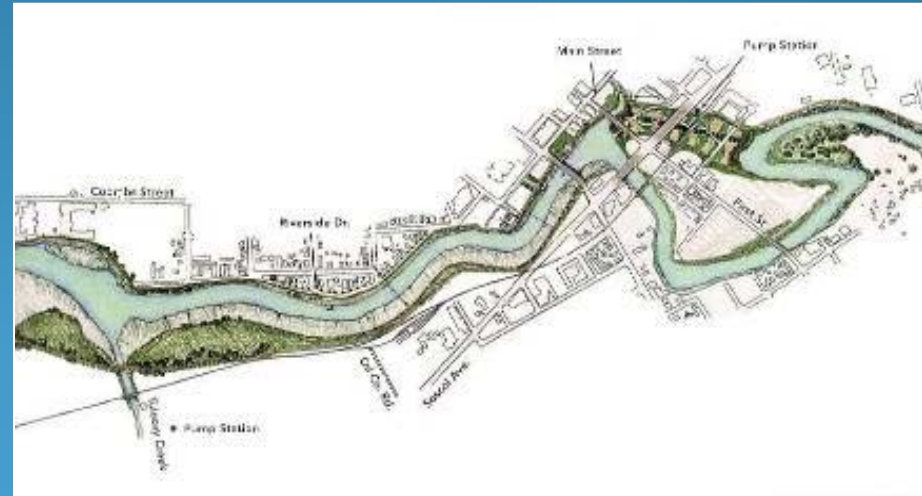

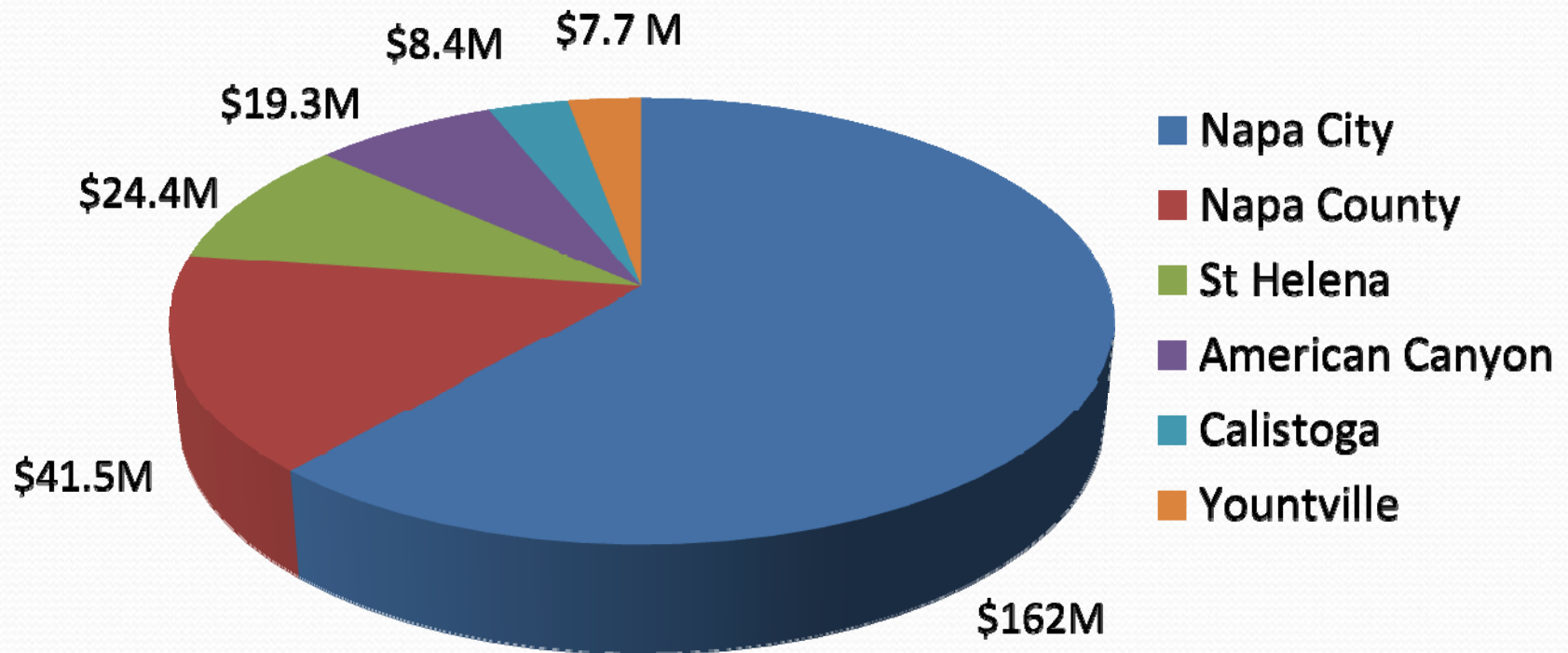

# Measure A Sales Tax Revenues

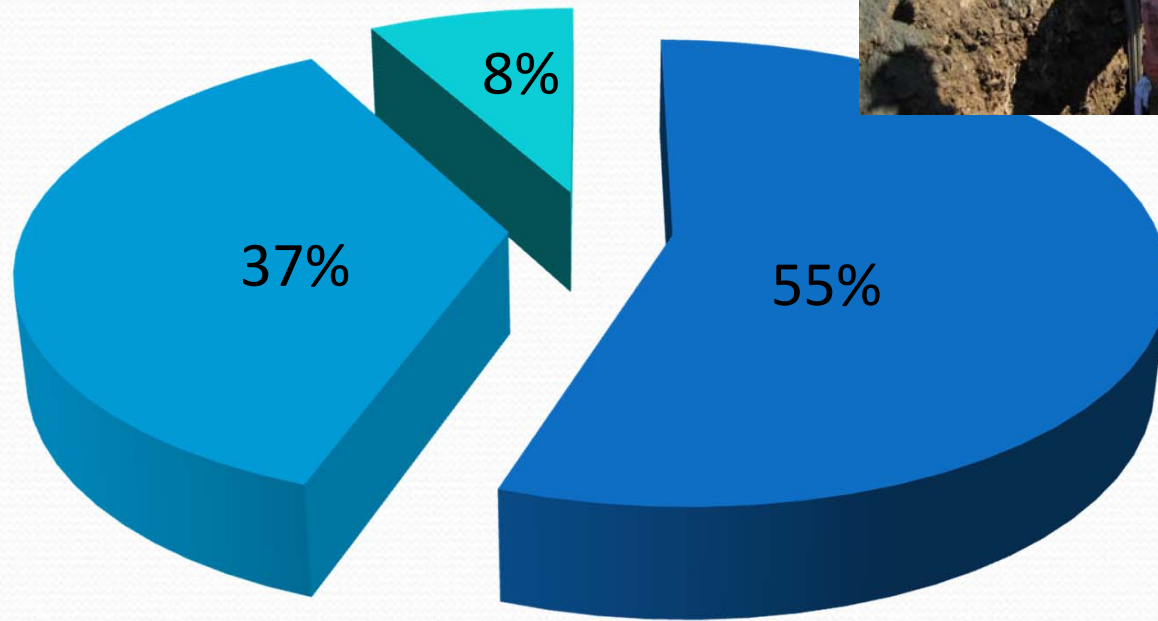


**\$262.3M - All Jurisdictions (1998-2018)**

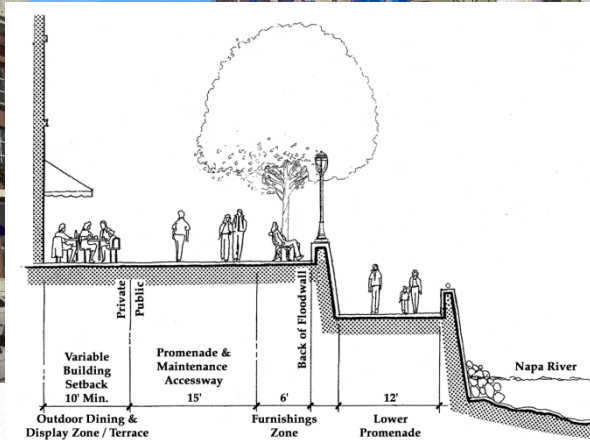

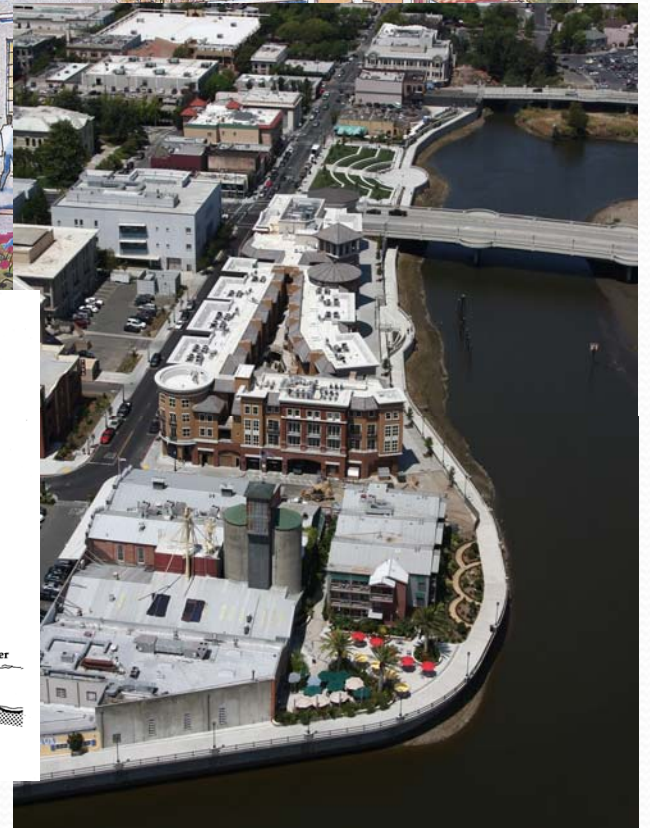
