Overview of the NCSPPP

- ⦿ Consortium of entities formed as JPA:
 - American Canyon
 - City of Napa
 - County of Napa
 - St. Helena
 - Yountville
 - Calistoga
 - Flood Control District *
- ⦿ Regulated under a Phase II NPDES permit:
 - Allows discharge stormwater from **MS4...**
 - If they follow **BMPs** (best management practices)
- ⦿ Existing permit issued in 2003; new permit coming soon....
- ⦿ Regulations stem from the Clean Water Act
 - Phase II – small MS4s, ie. <100,000 population
 - Phase I – large MS4s, ie. > 100,000 population

* not named as discharger in NPDES permit

6 Minimum Control Measures

- ⦿ Public Education
- ⦿ Public Participation
- ⦿ Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination
- ⦿ Construction Site Storm Water Runoff Control
- ⦿ Post Construction Storm Water Management
- ⦿ Pollution Prevention/Good Housekeeping for Municipal Operations

6 Minimum Control Measures

- Some things are done by cities individually



Like good housekeeping at corporation yards

- Other things done collectively on a Countywide basis



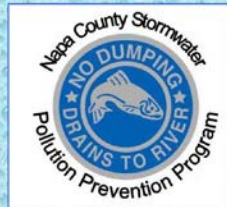
Like Coastal Cleanup events organized by the Napa RCD

Program Funding

- Parcel tax assessments ~ 20%
- General Fund ~ 80%
- **Program** Budget in FY 2012/2013 = \$218,740*
- * This does NOT include money spent by individual cities/towns/Co. on their own individual programs.

What the Future Holds...

- ⦿ A New NPDES permit
 - Adoption hearing December 5th
- ⦿ More requirements
- ⦿ More prescriptive requirements
- ⦿ Need for more funding
- ⦿ Need for greater collaboration and creativity in maintaining permit compliance
